The following revision was made to page 30 of the *Test Administrator's Manual* (TAM), now available on the [Vermont Help and Support website](#).

The previous CBT directions noted that students could not use a calculator in mathematics grade 9, Session 1. This has been revised to match the directions in TestNav that a student may use a calculator.

[If administering **mathematics CAT or Accommodations for grade 9**, say the following.]

**Today you will take a test in mathematics.**

**For this test, you will answer different types of questions. Some of the questions may look different from test questions you have seen before, and some may ask about material that is new to you, but it is important to do your best.**

**If you are not sure of the answer to a question, you should still try to answer it.**

**You may use a calculator to answer the questions in this session.**
