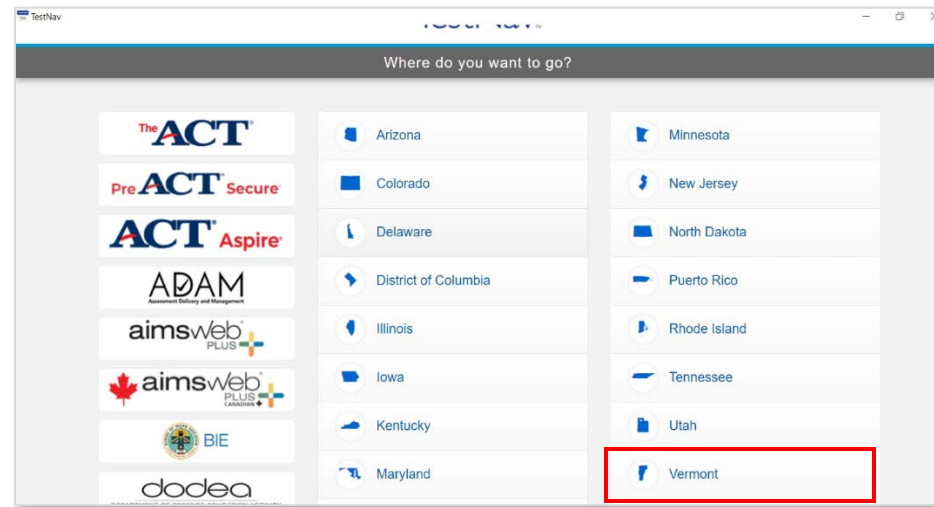


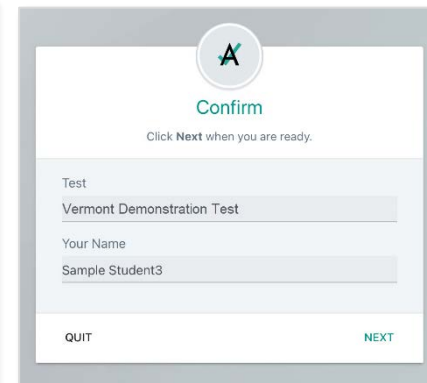
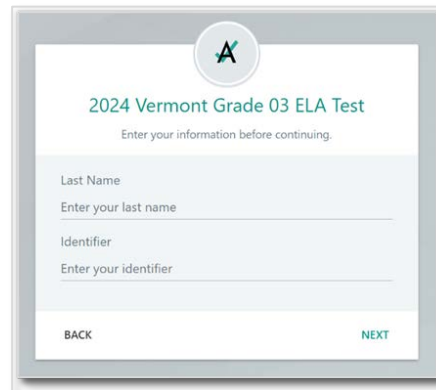
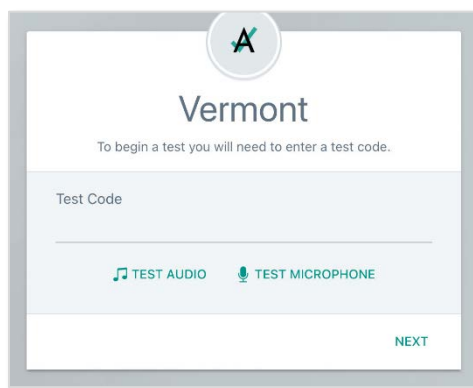
TestNav Student Interface

Logging In

1. Open the TestNav app on your device. On the "Where do you want to go?" page, select Vermont.

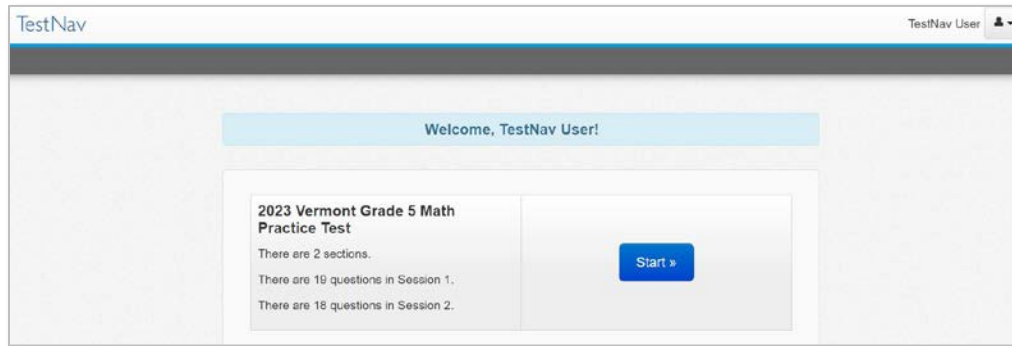


2. Log in to the assessment.
 - a. On the login screen, enter the Test Code provided by your proctor, then click Next.
 - b. On the next screen, enter your last name and state student ID, then click Next.
 - c. The confirmation screen will display the test name and your name. Ensure that both are accurate, then click Next.

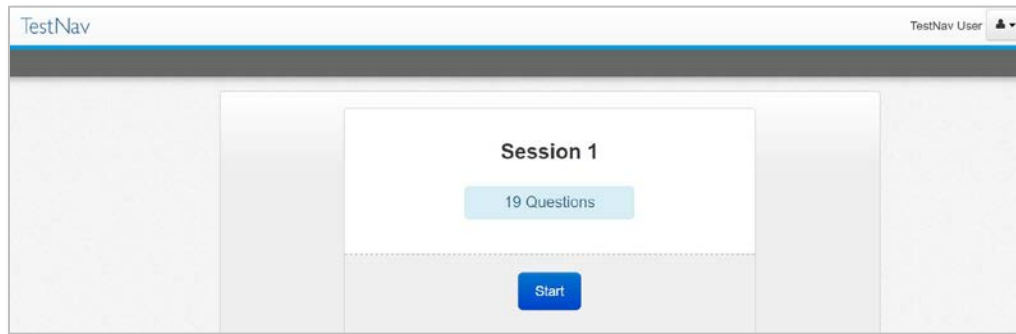


3. Begin the assessment.

- a. The welcome screen will display the test name and session information. Your information will be in the upper right-hand corner. If all of this information is accurate, click Start.



- b. On the session page, click Start again.



Tools and Site Navigation

Within the test, the following functions and tools will be available.

- D. Tools:** available tools will be displayed above the item. In this example, the mouse pointer, notepad, answer eliminator, and calculator are available.
- E. Additional supports:** Click the person icon in the upper right-hand corner to display a list of available supports.
- F. Text to Speech:** If Text to Speech (TTS) is enabled for the assessment, the TTS controls will display on the right-hand side of the screen.
 - a. TTS controls include play, toggle click-to-hear, jump back, skip ahead, and settings.
 - b. Within settings, you can adjust the speed and volume.
